- 1 Im ersten Teil (siehe Zeile 1–12) sprechen sieben Jugendliche. Außerdem wird noch über zwei andere Personen gesprochen. Wie heißen die?
- 2 Aunt Mabel (Zeile 5) und Mamud (Z. 9) und „mum“ (Z. 11). Worüber sprechen die sieben? (Z. 1–12)
- 3 Über sich selbst. Deine Aufgabe steht in Zeile 13. Was musst du tun?
- 4 *report* (= Bericht), *what they said* (= was sie sagten) *the missing names* (= die fehlenden Namen) (Z. 13). Wo steht der Bericht? Wo sollst du also fehlende Namen einsetzen?
- 5 In Zeile 14 bis 34. Da steht eigentlich genau dasselbe wie oben, nur dass die Jugendlichen nicht selbst sprechen, sondern es wird **über** sie gesprochen. Was musst du tun?
- 6 Du musst also Zeile für Zeile den unteren Text mit dem oberen vergleichen. Wenn du dieselben Aussagen findest, weißt du auch, wer etwas gesagt hat. Ein Beispiel:
- 7 Wer mag Autos (*like cars*) und will nach der Schule Automechanikerin werden (*want to be a car mechanic*)? (vergleiche Z. 1, Z. 14/15) Das war Ann. Trage den Namen jetzt in die erste Lücke ein.
