

Every case of sanctification is unique – as unique as the holy man or woman at its centre. Yet at the same time the problem posed is a general one: how does an individual become a Saint? In this bold and pioneering study the author answers the question by providing a detailed analysis of the case of the late twelfth- and early thirteenth-century Byzantine holy man, the Cypriot Saint Neophytos the Recluse.

In this interdisciplinary analysis the author addresses three different but closely interconnected aspects of reality: the factual, the cultural and the personal. In so doing, she establishes events, names, dates, places; she examines aspects of the thoughts, mentalities, ideologies and other cultural processes at work in the society of which Neophytos was a member; and she focuses on the subjective realities of Neophytos the man: his surviving writings are considered together with the paintings in the caves of his monastery, to offer a rare insight into the thought-world of a Byzantine holy man. In placing Neophytos within the context both of Cypriot Orthodox society and of the wider Byzantine world, such matters are discussed as education, secular and ecclesiastical politics, the relationship between Constantinople and her provinces, and the effects on this relationship of the fall of the Queen City to the crusading armies in 1204.

The study traces the evolution of Neophytos' belief in his own sanctity and his idiosyncratic pursuit of self-sanctification, before it proceeds to reconstruct the long, complex and continuous interaction between Recluse and society – an interaction which culminated in his sanctification. This process is analysed on the basis of the surviving textual and pictorial evidence, but also in terms of social anthropology, sociology and psychoanalysis. The author's care in defining her terms throughout the book will ensure its accessibility both to the specialist and to the interested general reader.


