This volume of the Lecture Notes in Computer Science series contains the proceedings of the Second Conference on Numerical Analysis and Applications, which was held at the University of Rousse, Bulgaria, June 11-15, 2000. The conference was organized by the Department of Numerical Analysis and Statistics at the University of Rousse with support from the University of Southern Mississippi, Hattiesburg.
