## **Preface**

This volume contains the final proceedings for the Sixth Workshop on Open Hypermedia Systems (OHS6) and the Second Workshop on Structural Computing (SC2). Both workshops were held at the 11th ACM Conference on Hypertext and Hypermedia in San Antonio, Texas, USA from 30 May to 3 June 2000. These workshops are organized under the umbrella of the Open Hypermedia Systems Working Group (OHSWG, <a href="http://www.ohswg.org/">http://www.ohswg.org/</a>). The OHSWG was formed at OHS2 in 1996 and its primary focus is enabling interoperability between open hypermedia systems. Each workshop addresses this goal from different perspectives (see the introductions to each workshop for more details).
